The Esther B. Clark School is designed for children ages 8 to 14 whose persistent difficulty self-managing their emotions and behavior negatively affects their relationships and work performance in school, at home and in the community.

We provide a small, personalized yet highly structured classroom setting with a 1:4 staff to student ratio. Staff consists of a credentialed special education teacher, trained behavior specialist and licensed therapist.

In addition to the full array of academic subjects scheduled daily, we offer:

- Music and Art Therapy
- Crisis Management Services
- Directed Positive Behavior Teaching
- Remedial Specialists in reading, language arts and math.
- Family Therapy and Behavior Management Training for Parents/Guardians

As private pay clientele, the family and child are given the same full day integrated academic, behavioral and therapeutic services offered our publicly funded children and families.

Many of our children are dealing with issues such as:

- Anxiety
- Mood Disorder
- Depression
- Specific Learning Disabilities
 - Anger Management
 - Peer relationship problems
 - Attention deficits
- Disconnect between intent and action
 - Lack of self-awareness
